

INTRODUCTION

This site contains a virtually complete assembly of the Order of the Arrow memorabilia issued by Ganosote 159, Tuscarora 284, and Ho-De-No-Sau-Nee Lodge 159. Also included are Pre-OA Honorary Societies and Organizations from the area. These lodges and societies were formerly from the Buffalo Council, Buffalo Area Council, Erie County Council, Niagara Falls Council, Niagara Frontier Council, and the current Greater Niagara Frontier Council (GNFC).

Lodge issue flaps, round and odd shapes, jacket patches, neckerchief patches and slides, embroidered and silk-screened neckerchiefs, chapter and event patches, and fakes are all represented. An attempt was made to identify the memorabilia designer (or individual most responsible for the design), the year the item was issued, and the number produced. A lodge history, including location, charter and merger dates, and the names of past and current chapters, were detailed prior to each respective memorabilia listing. Items have been identified using the same approach utilized by the Blue Book.

All images are represented in color. The vast majority of the items were scanned at high resolution. The format of this book is designed to ensure future additions can be easily integrated into the main body of the text. Ancillary materials (scanned copies of paper material such as camp photos, lodge pamphlets, newsletters, banquet programs, etc) will be included on the companion web site (see below).

Western New York Scout Honor Societies & Pre-Order of the Arrow Organizations

Early in the history of the Boy Scouts of America, prior to the existence of the National Order of the Arrow (OA), there existed many fraternal or honor camper societies across the country. Some of these, like the precursor to the present Order of the Arrow (Wimachtendienk W.W.), Firecrafters, Ku-Ni-eh, and Tribe of Gimogash existed across several councils (https://oa-bsa.org/history/non-oa-camp-fraternities). Other societies were only on a few camps within a specific council. Many of these groups became lodges within the Order of Arrow when the OA became the official BSA honor society in 1948. Most of the councils that existed in Western New York had honor camper awards. Some council programs resulted in honor campers receiving a special patch or emblem (e.g., Ti-Wa-Ya-Ee Blue Emblem). Other honor camper programs provided a patch and bestowed a special rank on campers (e.g., Crimson Arrow). Documentation varies between camps. However, it does not appear that these honor campers met to any great extent outside of the camp environment which brings into question the degree to which these could be considered an honor society or organization. Nonetheless, the various programs are presented in this section for informational purposes. Troop camping awards are not listed in this section.

Buffalo Council

Wakondale Tribe of the Ohiyese Indians (1914-1918)

Much of the early Western New York history was compiled by Paul Freitag. According to Paul, in 1914, the third summer camp held by the Buffalo Council, was named Camp Ohiyesa (pronounced Ohesa). The camp was held at Cascade Park, two miles from Springville. New York adjacent to the Buffalo, Rochester, and Pittsburgh railroad line. The camp name Ohiyesa, came from the Sioux word meaning winner. The camp initiated a points system for securing honors (1 point = 1 honor). When a scout earned 100 points, he was presented with the camp emblem. These points were earned by: identifying and collecting nature items, for work on the cooks squad, grounds committee, sanitary duties, campfire, scout craft, and camp inspection. When a scout had successfully accumulated 200 points, he was presented with a camp pennant. The design for the camp emblem was a large C and an O for Camp Ohiyesa. In 1915, the fourth season, one of the new features, was the creation of an Indian village. The Wakondale Tribe of the Ohiyese Indians were in charge of the village. One of the features of the village was the induction of tested scouts into the Wakondale Tribe (once every week) by the Chief. A scout winning 100 points in camp tests covering woodcraft and camp duties becomes a candidate for the tribe and was awarded a white feather. After winning 200 points a scout received an Indian name and became a papoose in the village. When 300 points was reached, he became an Indian boy. At 400 points a young brave, 500 points a warrior. Each degree had a separate password. The points also earned other things, 100 a camp emblem, 200 a gym jersey etc. Only 5 scouts ever earned a total of 500 points for a season. The Wakondale Tribe of the Ohiyese Indians was followed by the Tribe of Wokanda in 1919. Documentation is available on the website. No memorabilia have been discovered.

Wo-Kan-Da Indian Tribe (1919-1949)

The Wo-Kan-Da Indian Tribe (a Lakota Sioux word meaning *Great Mystery*) was present at Camp Scouthaven from 1919 until 1949 when Buffalo Council merged with the Erie County Council and formed Ganosote Lodge. The program was overhauled in 1930 to better match with the six scout ranks. When scouts entered Camp Scouthaven they choose one of four trails or clans: Natureclan,

Waterclan, Campclan, or Artclan. By completing various tasks, a Tenderfoot Scout could earn and wear the Papoose Award (Little Wigwam Teepee patch), a Second Class Scout could be awarded the Brave Rank (Lone Wolf head patch), and a First Class Scout could earn the Hunter Award (Headache Stick tomahawk patch). After a scout achieved the Hunter Rank he was qualified to become a Warrior and wear the Crimson Arrow following the completion of several tests (Star Scout plus additional tasks). The Crimson Arrow was an arrow shaped patch that was a red felt arrow sewed on to white felt and was worn above the pocket on the scout uniform. The arrow was rather large, measuring about 5-6 inches in length. To become the Sachem of the Tribe and wear the Tall Pine patch, a scout had to achieve Life Scout and complete additional tasks. Lastly, to be known as a Chief of the Wo-Kan-Da Tribe and wear the Flying Eagle a scout must obtain Eagle Scout and complete various additional tasks. Evidence exists that the Crimson Arrow existed as early as 1923 and possibly earlier. OA Lodge 186 in Bath, New York was named Wokonda. It is unknown if the lodge name came from the society. Documentation is available on the website. Photos are presented in this document. Reproductions and possible examples of memorabilia are also provided.

Buffalo/Buffalo Area Council

Tonka Coo Awards (1926-1960s)

Belt painting at Camp Scouthaven was started in 1926 as a scout craft recognition. It soon expanded to include other recognitions. The "Tonka Coo" awards were painted on the scout belt by the person who received them. This practice took place at Scouthaven and after the 1949 merger at Camp Ti-Wa-Ya-Ee. The legend of Tonka Coo was an Indian Chief meaning "Little Deeds" who would come over Crystal Lake light the campfire at Camp Scouthaven for each week of camp. The image of Tonka Coo is prominent on Scouthaven patches. No official documentation is available. Memorabilia examples are presented in this publication.

Erie County Council

Emblem Award (1930s through early 1940s)

Camp Ti-Wa-Ya-Ee was the primary summer camp of the Erie County Council (ECC) from 1928 until the council merged with the Buffalo Council in 1949. Campers at Ti-Wa-Ya-Ee were awarded one of three felt emblems depending on how their fellow campers and counselors rated them on a series of characteristics associated with being a good camper. These characteristics were each scored on a 1-10% scale and included: 1) Teamwork, 2) Cheerful, 3) Helpful, 4) Sincerity and Good Conduct, 5) Reliable, 6) Clean, 7) Initiative, 8) Self-Reliant, 9) Perseverance, 10) Reverent. Scouts whose average percentage ranks them in the top 20% of the entire camp earned the blue emblem. The red emblem was awarded to those campers whose average percentage ranked them in the top 40%. The gold emblem was awarded to all other scouts who scored above 65%. This honor program is well documented in several publications. These are available on the website. Memorabilia is provided in this publication.

The early program used felt emblems which did not contain the name of the camp. Likely in the late 30s or early 40s the camp began using twill patches with the camp name. However, the colors differed from the earlier awards and included red and green. These twill emblems were likely not used as honor camper awards.

Niagara Falls Area Council/Niagara Frontier Council

Tonca Coo (1920s-1940s)

Tonca Coo was used as a camp recognition program at Camp Moss in the Niagara Falls Area Council. Camp Moss was purchased in 1921. The camp served the needs of the Niagara Falls Area Council until 1942 when it became inadequate in area and facilities. There are not much memorabilia from Camp Moss. A camp pennant exists and a 1941 Tonca Coo patch. Tonca Coo was translated from the Indian name meaning "Little Deeds." The spelling of Tonca Coo is unique to Camp Moss. Several other camps such as Camp Scouthaven (Buffalo Area Council) and Camp Aquehonga (Ten Mile River Scout Reservation) used a Tonka Coo award but spelled with a k instead of a c in Tonka. It is unclear whether the Tonca Coo award continued to be used after the council stopped using Camp Moss (e.g., Camp Thunder Rock, Stonehaven, Northern Lights). No documentation exists regarding this program. Memorabilia are provided in this publication.





GANOSOTE LODGE 159

Lodge History

Ganosote Lodge was formed in Erie County Council in 1921 by Hans Walter, the chairman of the Camping Committee. On June 23, 1939 the Erie Councy Council Scout Executive put forth an application for an Order of the Arrow Lodge to support the council's senior scout activities. The lodge was intended to function at Camp Ti-Wa-Ya-Ee. The application was approved by the National Lodge on July 7, 1939 and was assigned Lodge 159. The name "Ganosote" means "longhouse," the living building of the Iroquois. The first Western New York Order of the Arrow induction was held in 1939 at camp Ti-Wa-Ya-Ee. In the charter application, the Lodge selected Howard Seitz as the Lodge Chief and Dr. Earl Ploss as the Lodge Advisor.

In 1949, the Erie County Council merged with the Buffalo Council to form the Buffalo Area Council. Buffalo Council had an organization similar to the Order of the Arrow called the "Tribe of the Wo-Kan-Da." This organization was dissolved, and the new council adopted the OA and continued the name and totem of Ganosote. In January of 1953 the first issue of the lodge flap and neckerchief went on sale. By 1965, Ganosote Lodge was the largest lodge in the United States.

In Spring 1967, the Greater Niagara Frontier Council was formed through the merger of the Niagara Frontier Council (Tuscarora Lodge) and the Buffalo Area Council (Ganosote Lodge). A new merged Lodge was formed, taking the name Ho-De-No-Sau-Nee, meaning "People of the Longhouse."







Lodge History

On June 15, 1944, the camping committee of the Niagara Frontier Council adopted a resolution to form an Order of the Arrow Lodge to operate at Camp Thunder Rock, Camp Moss, and/or various Troop Camps in the area. The National Lodge approved the application on January 4, 1945 and assigned the number 284 to the local lodge resulting in the creating of Tuscarora Lodge 284. The five original members came from all over the United States. One, Frank Dominguez, III was inducted into the OA in 1937 at Hart Scout Reservation in the Philadelphia Council where the OA was introduced to Scouting. He was the Lodge advisor for several years. In August of 1945, the first Ordeal ceremony was held on the Tuscarora Indian Reservation. The name Tuscarora was taken as the Lodge name. The name means the "Shirt Wearers."

Lodge History

In early spring 1967, the Greater Niagara Frontier Council was formed from the merger of the Niagara Frontier Council (Tuscarora Lodge) and the Buffalo Area Council (Ganosote Lodge). A new merged Lodge was formed, taking the name Ho-De-No-Sau-Nee, meaning "People of the Longhouse." The new lodge quickly adopted the Iroquois longhouse with six smokestacks (one for each of the six tribes of the Iroquois) as its totem.

An interim lodge chief (Paul Murray) was chosen to lead the lodge until elections were held at the spring lodge conclave. Mark Warner was elected and became the first official Ho-De-No-Sau-Nee lodge chief. Initially, the lodge had fourteen chapters (twelve from Ganosote and two from Tuscarora). However, a year after the merger the number of chapters was reduced to twelve. In 1970, the Niagara Falls chapters merged. In 1983, 1986, and 1990 there were a series of chapter mergers. Finally, from 1990 until 2002 there were only three chapters. Things changed in 2002 when the lodge added a chapter (Theodore Roosevelt).

In 2004 the Council split three of the four districts in half. The chapters retained the same boundaries with Onondaga Chapter containing Cayuga & Iroquois Trail Districts. Polaris Chapter was made up of Niagara Gateway & Tonawanda Districts. Silver Lakes Chapter was made up of Erie Shores & Southern Hills Districts. Theodore Roosevelt Chapter was the Theodore Roosevelt District.

In 2007 the Theodore Roosevelt Chapter merged with the Onondaga Chapter. Silver Lakes Chapter changed its name to Seneca Chapter. Polaris Chapter changed its name to Falling Waters. Since 2007, Lodge 159 has three chapters: Falling Waters, Onondaga, and Seneca.
