- 1. Laugh—2 months
- 2. Pedal a tricycle—24 months
- 3. Sit without support—5–6 months
- 4. Feel ashamed—2 years
- 5. Walk unassisted—12 months
- 6. Stand on one foot for 10 seconds—4¹/2 years
- 7. Recognize and smile at mother or father—4–5 months
- 8. Kick ball forward—20 months
- 9. Think about things that cannot be seen—2 years
- 10. Make two-word sentences—20–22 months
